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SP022 - ST ANN'S COLLEGE COVID VACCINATION POLICY

PURPOSE

To ensure that St Ann's College employees, students and visitors are protected, so far as is reasonably practicable, from COVID-19 and its most significant impacts.

POLICY STATEMENT

St Ann's College is committed to protecting employees, students, contractors and all others who may visit the college premises, from COVID-19 infection. St Ann's College supports the importance of discussion and promotion around an individual's freedom of choice however the College has a duty to provide a safe environment for all students, staff and visitors.

APPLICATION

As of the 31st of January 2023, it will be mandatory for all students, staff, contractors, Council and Foundation Committee members who wish to gain access to the site and/or sites to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 as per SA Health guidelines with an Australian Health Department approved COVID-19 vaccine.

Exemption to this policy due to medical grounds will be considered upon production of an official SA Health approved exemption.

MONITORING

- All **staff** must provide proof of vaccination by the 26th of January 2023.
- All **students** must provide proof of vaccination prior to receiving their room keys. Students who cannot show proof will not be allowed to reside in the college.
- All **volunteers** e.g., Council must produce proof the first time they visit the College from 26th January 2023.
- All **contractors** must show proof of vaccination immediately when they enter the site and prior to commencing work from 26th January 2023.

Proof of vaccination can be supplied to any of the office staff during office hours. Out of office hours, proof of vaccination must be provided to either a Residential Advisor, Dean or Principal. Vaccination records will be maintained in a confidential register.

Those required to but who cannot prove they have been fully vaccinated will be asked to leave the College premises until they can show proof. All decisions regarding exemptions will be made by the Principal or the Principal's delegate and will be final.

*This policy is subject to change at any time on receipt of advice from SA Health and/or during a regular policy review.

St Ann's College has various policies which protect all people and facilities associated with the College. The St Ann's Council has endorsed these policies and empowered the Principal and their delegates to ensure that they are followed. It is a condition of your residency/employment that you agree to abide by these policies at all times.
